This permanent position, under the supervision of the Fort Assiniboine Road Supervisor, is responsible for the operation of heavy equipment and required to perform general labour duties within the field operations.

Functional Responsibilities

- Operating assigned heavy equipment used in construction projects and the maintenance of roadways.
- Performing equipment pre-trips and reporting equipment defects.
- Servicing, maintaining, and performing minor operational repairs when operating assigned equipment.
- Assist with the maintenance of all County facilities, as directed by the Road Supervisor, in accordance with the County's maintenance plan.
- Reporting any deficiencies of infrastructure assets and requests from residents to the Road Supervisor.

Functional Requirements

- Required to work outside in all weather conditions.
- Typical work sites include a high level of noise, dust, grease, mud, moving vehicles or machines and temperatures varying from very hot to very cold.
- Normal safety precautions are required including the use of PPE such as safety boots, high visibility vest, and hearing protection.
- Requires some physical exertion, such as periods of standing, walking over rough and uneven terrain, and recurring bending, crouching, stooping, and reaching.
- Medium-to-high physical labour required.

Qualification & Education Requirements

- Grade 12 diploma or equivalent.
- Possess a valid Class 3 driver's license with air brake (Q) endorsement, Class 1 preferred.
- 3 5 years experience operating heavy duty equipment including trucks, graders, loaders, excavators, and other related equipment.
- Ability to work on-call, work alone.
