

Cutbanks Road Bank Repair

The Cutbanks Road Bank Repair project has been identified in the Provincial Disaster Recovery Program (DRP) because of extensive damage to the south bank of the river during the flooding in 2023. The Province has determined eligibility based on 140m of bank repair as estimated in the red box area below, with a final recovery reimbursement of a 90%-10% split between the Province and the County.

The current approval from Council is for Administration to engage with engineering and environmental services to proceed with project design. Administration will be designing the project to provide flexibility in deciding what to tender; also, would provide possibilities for applications under other grant funding programs.

It is estimated that design will be completed in 2025, permitting will commence in 2025 and extend into 2026, and construction in 2026. Construction cost will be added in to the 2026 budget, with identification that 90% of the funding required for the DRP- eligible scope will be coming from the DRP.
