

Title: Gravel

Policy Statement: To outline the gravelling requirements for the Municipality.

1. Regular Road Gravelling:
 - a) Up to 200 cubic meters (315 tonne) per kilometer on local roads of 7/8" gravel.
 - b) Up to 270 cubic meters (440 tonne) per kilometer on secondary highways.
 - c) Should more gravel be required per mile, the Area Supervisor or Director of Infrastructure Services are authorized to provide necessary amounts.
2. Construction Gravelling:
 - a) Initial Lift of 2" shall be packed into the road surface, followed by 7/8" crushed.
 - b) Approaches replaced during new construction or regrading and new approaches will be gravelled.
3. Residents requesting to purchase gravel from the County will be directed to purchase gravel from the private contractors in the area.
4. Requests by rural community halls, cemeteries and other institutions or individuals may be considered by Council.
5. Truckers, while working for the Municipality, are to travel at posted speed limits. Truckers are to use the roads courteously, considering such factors as privacy, noise levels and road conditions. A municipal employee may issue a

warning to a non-complying operator. Repeat offenders may be suspended from further hauling.

6. The Director of Infrastructure Services will prepare an annual regravelling program which shall be approved by Council.
