

**Title: Agricultural Water Use**

**Policy Statement:** To establish guidelines for the approval of requests for use of Woodland County's Truck Fill Stations located in Fort Assiniboine and Anselmo.

1. The purpose of the Truck Fill Stations is to provide agricultural users with a secure and adequate supply of non-potable water. The County shall provide this service at no charge to Woodlands County ratepayers that show proof of landownership when picking up keys available at the Whitecourt and Fort Assiniboine offices, for the Truck Fill Stations.
2. Industrial and commercial use of the Truck Fill Stations is discouraged where suitable alternatives may be available.
3. When industrial or commercial users residing in Woodlands County request access to the Truck Fill Stations operated by Woodlands County, Administration shall review the current loading and usage of the facilities to determine whether sufficient excess capacity exists to accommodate the request.
4. Should the capacity of the Truck Fill Stations be reached or exceeded at any time in the future, industrial or commercial users residing in Woodlands County will be required to discontinue use of the stations and surrender their keys. Industrial and commercial users shall surrender keys before agricultural users.
5. A key deposit of \$150.00 shall be charged to all industrial or commercial users.
6. A fee of \$25.00 shall be charged to replace lost keys.
