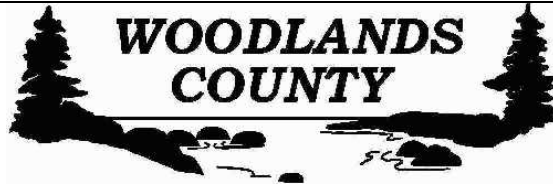


Title: Operation of Transfer Stations

Policy Statement: To establish rules and regulations for the operation of transfer stations within Woodlands County.

Transfer Stations

1. Signs shall be in place stipulating Transfer Station usage is restricted to Woodland County landowners only.
2. Designated areas will be allocated to ensure separation of clean wood, metal, wire, tires, batteries, used oil, used oil containers and E-waste with signage in place identifying the designated drop off areas
3. Woodlands County issued Transfer Site I.D. Cards will be mandatory for usage of all County operated transfer sites:
 - 3.1 ID Cards must be shown to the transfer site operator prior to obtaining access to the site.
 - 3.1.1 Each landowner will receive one Transfer Station ID Card; however, a second card may be issued at a later date upon request.
 - 3.2 Each landowner within Woodlands County will receive notification pertaining to the implementation of the new Transfer Station ID Card System.
 - 3.2.1 A one month transition period from the date of approval shall be in place to ensure appropriate notice is provided to all Transfer Site users. During this transitional period unauthorized users will be advised of the new program and allowed to use the facility one last time.
 - 3.3 New landowners within Woodlands County will receive their Transfer Station ID Cards via regular post office mail.
