

Students will receive a grant of \$2,000 for first year bursaries and \$1,000 for second year bursaries for a total of \$3,000 over two years. They must be full time students and enrolled in post secondary courses in a recognized and accredited post secondary educational institute. Applicants must successfully complete a minimum of three (3) courses per semester or trimester to qualify for that portion of the scholarship.
If a graduating high school student takes up to three school years off prior to attending a post secondary institution, the student would still be eligible for the bursary. If the time off is beyond three years, the student will forfeit his/her eligibility for this bursary.
Applicants are only eligible to receive this bursary once.
