

**Title:** Texas Gates

**Policy Statement:** To establish procedures and guidelines for the installation of texas gates on undeveloped road allowances.

1. Applications for the installation of texas gates will only be considered on undeveloped road allowances where the applicant has title to or use of lands directly adjacent to the road allowance or requires use of the road allowance to access land for resource exploration or extraction.
2. All applications must receive approval of the Council prior to the installation of the proposed texas gate.
3. The minimum dimensions of the texas gate shall be sixteen (16) feet in width and eight (8) feet in length with a minimum of eight (8) inches between pipes. Any variations from these dimensions must receive approval of the Director of Infrastructure Services prior to the application being approved by the Council.
4. The material proposed to construct the texas gate must be of a strength that is sufficient to meet the needs of the road traffic and must receive approval of the Director of Infrastructure Services prior to the application being approved by Council.
5. Texas gates shall be supplied and installed at the applicant's cost, subject to the specifications imposed by the Director of Infrastructure Services.
