

Title: Road Numbering

Policy Statement: To identify a uniform numbering system for local roads.

A provincial system of road numbering based on range and township numbers will be adopted. It is as follows:

1. EAST - WEST ROADS

(Example: The road east of Range 6 will be called Rge Rd 600; one mile West will be Rge Rd 610; One and one-half miles west will be Rge Rd 615; two miles west will be Rge Rd 620 and so on.)

2. NORTH - SOUTH ROADS

(Example: The road south of Township 39 will be Twp Rd 390; one mile north will be Twp Rd 391; two miles will be Twp Rd 392 and so on).

3. OTHER LOCAL ROADS

Other local roads with specific names will be named as such (give example) in conjunction with the numbered sign.

4. Signs will be placed at each intersection on the northeast corner of the intersection approximately on the property line.

5. When the complete program is in place, an information bulletin will be sent out to each taxpayer with their tax notices explaining the system.
