

Title: Road Line Painting

Policy Statement: To assist the travelling public, the Council will provide and maintain painted centerlines on all surfaced roadways.

1. Upon resurfacing or surfacing of any roadway, the Director of Infrastructure Services will provide for the painting of centerlines.
2. In addition, shoulder lines will be painted on all secondary highways.
3. All center and shoulder lines will be painted in accordance with the Manual of Geometric Design Standards for Canadian Roads as published by the Road and Transportation Association of Canada.
4. It is expected that painted lines should last three years. The Director of Infrastructure Services will schedule the repainting of those lines identified by himself and Council as being faded to the extent that they are not visible, or nearly not visible, in normal weather conditions. Any repainting or painting of resurfaced roadways will be coordinated each year to ensure that maximum efficiencies can be realized when hiring painting contractors.
5. The Director of Infrastructure Services will seek and receive approval of Council for any proposed painting contract.
6. Council will approve funds in the annual municipal budget for line painting.
7. Painting contracts will be tendered whenever possible.
