

Title: Waterline Crossings on Road Allowances

Policy Statement: To establish a criteria for allowing waterline crossings on road allowances within the Woodlands County.

1. The Municipality will allow waterline crossings on road allowances, subject to a written application to Council and subject to the following conditions:
 - a) Written approval from Council prior to any construction occurring;
 - b) Submission to Council of a detailed plan of the proposed crossing;
 - c) Applicant shall accept responsibility for road closure to include proper signs and barricades to ensure safety of the operation.
 - d) Applicant shall accept responsibility for any accidents and/or injuries due to or as a result of construction taking place;
 - e) Applicant shall accept responsibility for any repairs and/or damage caused by failure of and/or rupture to the waterline;
 - f) The installation depth shall be to a minimum of eight feet from the ditch grade to the top of the pipe;
 - g) Applicant shall accept responsibility for restoration of the road to its original condition, to include replacement of gravel and tamping;
 - h) Applicant shall accept responsibility for maintenance of road crossing area for a period of one year;
 - i) Applicant shall accept responsibility for installation of posts and signs on property lines on both sides of the road as per recommendations made by Council;
 - j) Applicant shall accept responsibility for alterations that may occur due to road construction;
 - k) Pushing of waterlines, rather than open trench digging, will be allowed in order to avoid extra costs of digging through paved surfaces;

- l) A deposit of \$150.00 will be required with all applications and will be refundable in full or in part if all of the above conditions are met;
- m) Temporary waterlines may be placed across the road allowances on individual application, based on conditions as set out in the approval.
