PURPOSE

To provide and maintain clear pavement markings to assist the traveling public by enhancing road safety and traffic flow.

POLICY STATEMENT

Woodlands County ensures clarity, safety and uniformity by outlining responsibilities for maintenance, establishing policies, procedures and standards, defining the conditions and process for painting and repainting based on factors like road resurfacing and wear, and specifying compliance with provincial guidelines and relevant environmental regulations.

DEFINITIONS

County: Means the municipality named Woodlands County.

ADMINISTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITY

Director, Infrastructure Services

Responsible for line painting to be provided.

GUIDELINES

Woodlands County will schedule the repainting of centerlines, edgelines, lane markings and pavement messages identified through an assessment as being faded to the extent that they are not visible, or nearly not visible, in normal weather conditions.

Upon resurfacing or surfacing of any hot mix roadway, the County will provide for the painting of centerlines, edgelines, lane markings and pavement messages.

Roadway lines will be painted and maintained in accordance with the applicable provincial Highway Pavement Marking Guide.
