

**WOODLANDS COUNTY
BYLAW 499/17
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**A BYLAW BEING ENACTED FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW 431/14 -
ESTABLISHING A COUNCIL PROCEDURES BYLAW FOR WOODLANDS COUNTY;**

WHEREAS Bylaw No. 431/14 was passed establishing a a council procedures Bylaw for Woodlands County;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Woodlands County deems it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 431/14;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Woodlands County, duly assembled, enacts the following:

1. That Woodlands County Bylaw No. 431/14 be, and is hereby amended, by deleting section:

23.1 “ For all Council meetings a record of all the votes shall be recorded.”

2. That Bylaw No. 431/14 be, and is hereby amended, by replacing section 25.1 with:

“A person may use or operate audio and or video recording devices at an open Council or committee meeting if they have informed the presiding member and others in the room that they will be doing so. If necessary, the presiding member may authorize the locations where audio and or video recording devices may be placed.”

3. That Bylaw No. 431/14 and amendments thereto shall, in all other respects, remain the same.

4. This Bylaw shall have force and take effect on the final reading thereof.
