Apply for disaster recovery funding if your home or business suffered flood damage in spring 2018.

If you live in Woodlands County, and your home, business or property was damaged by overland flooding in spring 2018, you may be eligible to receive Disaster Recovery Program (DRP) funding from the Government of Alberta.

The DRP provides funding for uninsurable property damage, loss and other expenses incurred as the result of a natural disaster.

Deadline to apply is January 2, 2019.
